Jonathan - Jono - Fischbach is the Associate General Counsel for the Science and Technology Law Division within the Office of General Counsel.

Mr. Fischbach most recently served as an Associate Deputy General Counsel at the Department of Defense (DoD), where his areas of practice included Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML), Commercially Available Information (CAI), Open Source Intelligence (OSINT), Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA), intelligence enterprise development, and intelligence oversight. In this capacity Mr. Fischbach led DoD's participation in numerous White House policy initiatives in the emerging technology domain, including the Executive

Order on the Safe, Secure, and Trustworthy Development and Use of Artificial Intelligence; the EU-US Data Privacy Framework; the Executive Order on Preventing Access to Americans' Bulk Sensitive Personal Data; the Executive Order on the Prohibition of Use of Commercial Spyware; and the Guiding Principles on Government Use of Surveillance Technologies.

Prior to joining DoD's Office of General Counsel, Mr. Fischbach was the Associate General Counsel for Technology and National Security Law at the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), where he served as chief legal counsel to DIA's Directorate of Analysis and Open Source Intelligence Integration Center. Mr. Fischbach was also a senior trial attorney in the Civil Rights Division at the Department of Justice, and represented the United States in the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court (FISC) and Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court of Review (FISC-R) on a variety of FISA-related oversight, operational, and transparency-related matters.

Mr. Fischbach received his Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree, cum laude, from Princeton University, and his Juris Doctor (JD), magna cum laude, from Cornell Law School, where he served as an editor on the Cornell Law Review. After graduating from law school Mr. Fischbach clerked for the Honorable Kermit V. Lipez on the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit, and is currently an adjunct professor at Georgetown Law Center and the William & Mary Whole of Government Center of Excellence.
