

# Michael M. Dulak

## Director, Counterintelligence & Identity Intelligence (CI2)

### Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence & Security OUSD(I&S)

Michael M. Dulak serves as the Director of CI2 in OUSD(I&S) and reports to the Director for Defense Intelligence (Counterintelligence, Law Enforcement, and Security). He is responsible for the policies, oversight, advocacy, guidance, and strategic direction of Department of Defense (DoD) Counterintelligence (CI), Identity Intelligence (I2) and biometrics programs and activities.



Mr. Dulak earned the rank of Defense Intelligence Senior Level (DISL) in March 2022. He has over 38 years of leadership and expertise in CI and the development and direction of multi-agency, sensitive, clandestine intelligence operations, with extensive experience in supporting national, operational and tactical CI activities and missions, strategic planning, policy formulation, and oversight.

Mr. Dulak retired in 2007 as U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer Four after 22 years of honorable military service as CI Special Agent. His civil service career assignments in the DoD include serving as a Senior Intelligence Official on the Army Staff (G-3/5/7) and as a Supervisory and Senior Program Analyst with the Department of the Air Force.

Mr. Dulak reported to OUSD(I&S) in January 2016, and before his promotion to DISL, served as the Deputy Director of CI Support to Research, Development and Acquisition; Chief of CI Sensitive Activities; Division Chief for CI and Executive Secretary to a 2019-2020 Defense Science Board CI Task Force; and acting Director for CI, I2 and Law Enforcement. Mr. Dulak transferred his role and responsibilities for law enforcement in January 2024 after a very successful two-year tour as its director, during which he led Federal law enforcement reforms within the Department resulting in the Deputy Secretary of Defense designating the USD(I&S) as the principal staff assistant for law enforcement.

Mr. Dulak was graduated cum laude with a Master of Arts in Military History from Norwich University. He earned a Bachelor of Arts in Government and Politics from the University of Maryland, University College in Heidelberg, Germany, and a Certificate in Criminal Justice Education from the University of Virginia through the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Academy (Class 208). His military education includes a Diploma in the German language from the Defense Language Institute - San Francisco, and graduation/certification from the Advanced Foreign CI Training Course.

Mr. Dulak's military decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, as well as a number of other medals, awards and commendations earned throughout a distinguished military career. His civilian achievements include Air Force Awards for Meritorious Civilian Service and Civilian Achievement.

Mr. Dulak was born and raised in Wisconsin. He and his wife Janice live in Northern Virginia. They have been married for over 37 years and together they have two children and five grandchildren. Mr. Dulak enjoys life as a husband, father, and grandfather, bass fisherman, and mastering the art of barbecue. He is also an avid student of General George Washington and the military history of the American Revolutionary War.
